Abstract

This course deals with trends and tools for the integration of Environmental, Social and Governance (ESG) criteria within organizations, addressing international standards, implementation frameworks, ESG risk identification, operational risk management approach based on case study analysis, and the disclosure and reporting of material sustainability issues required by mining investors.

The course content is aimed at strategic planning, financial and geological professionals and post-graduate students interested in leading the transformation of their organizations towards new market trends.
